

## Cookie Policy

In providing services to you and operating Forex Insiders ("Forex Insiders"), we may use certain monitoring technologies. Below is indicated which technology is used, what metrics we track, for what purpose. This cookie policy is part of our privacy policy, which also includes additional details about our information collection and usage.

### Definition of Cookies

We want to offer you the best possible online experience and use a small text file (cookie) that is stored in the browser of your computer, smartphone, or tablet when you visit our website. A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and is stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server. Cookies may not contain any information that personally identifies a user, but personal data that we store about you may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.

The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website. They ensure that the website works properly and, for example, remembering your preferred settings. By means of cookies we can also see how you use our website, allow us to learn about your visit and how we can make the website more user-friendly. Insofar as cookies that are not strictly necessary for the provision of our website and services, we will ask you to consent to our use of these cookies when you first visit our website.

### The Technologies We Use

#### Authentication token

Forex Insiders uses different applications that operate on different machines and to connect the applications with each other we store user's authentication token from one application and refer it in the other one. The web server will not need to keep a record of tokens as each is self-contained, including the data required to check its validity and convey the user information. These tokens are stored in a session storage and is cleared when the browser is closed.

#### Vimeo video player

We have embedded Vimeo videos within our website. The video portal is operated by Vimeo Inc., 555 West 18th Street, New York, New York 10011, USA.

The videos are stored on <https://vimeo.com/>. With the help of a plug-in, we can display high quality videos directly on our website. When you visit a page in which the video is embedded, a connection to the Vimeo servers is established and certain data may be transferred from you to Vimeo. Vimeo will be informed about which of our pages you have visited. In addition, Vimeo will receive your IP address. This also applies if you are not logged in to Vimeo when you visit our website or do not have a Vimeo account. The information is transmitted to a Vimeo server in the US, where it is stored. If you are logged in to your Vimeo account, Vimeo allows you to associate your browsing behaviour directly with your personal profile. You can prevent this by logging out of your Vimeo account. Purpose: This cookie saves your settings before you play an embedded Vimeo video. This means that the next time you watch a Vimeo video, you will get your preferred settings back.

Expiration date: after one year

Purpose: This cookie collects information about your actions on websites that have embedded a Vimeo video.

Expiration date: after 2 years

Note: These two cookies are always set when you are on a website with an embedded Vimeo video. When you view the video and click the button, for example to “share” or “link” the video, additional cookies are set. These are also third-party cookies such as `_ga` or `_gat_UA-76641-8` from Google Analytics or `_fbp` from Facebook. Exactly which cookies are set here depends on your interaction with the video. ### Disable and delete cookies

As the proper functioning of Forex Insiders relies on the use of a token of authentication shared only between the different applications within Forex Insiders server, if the user configures the browser to no longer support cookies, then parts of Forex Insiders service that rely on the authentication token will not function. In practice this means that any feature of Forex Insiders will become unavailable.

Don't want us to use non-functional cookies? You can easily turn them off. If you turn them off, you will not be able to use all the features on our website. You can disable and delete cookies via the browser settings of your computer. For example, if you do not want Vimeo to set cookies and thus collect information about you, you can delete or deactivate cookies in your browser settings at any time. Please note that after deactivating/deleting cookies, some functions may no longer be fully available.

We may update this Cookie Policy from time to time in order to reflect, for example, changes to the cookies or related technologies we use or for other operational, legal or regulatory reasons.
